DESCRIPTION AND TERMS – MAY 2021

Purpose of the Scholarship

Up to three tuition reduction scholarships up to 100%
The scholarship offers aid to promising Pierce students facing financial difficulties.

INTENT OF THE AWARD

This expendable scholarship has been established with the support of Stefatos Family and the Pierce Class of 1989 and friends and has a duration of six academic years.

EXTENT OF THE AWARD

The **Vani Stefatou Memorial & Pierce Class of 1989 Expendable Scholarship** provides tuition reduction for the duration of the recipient's studies at the College, based on the student's financial need and academic performance. Renewal of the award to the same or recipients will continue as long as they continue to meet the eligibility requirements and there is a sufficient balance.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To apply for the scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be an entering A' Gymnasium student
- Meet all College entrance requirements
- Score among the top 40 students on the Pierce entrance exam.
- Demonstrate financial need

To continue receiving the scholarship, the recipient(s) must achieve an academic performance of 18/20 at the end of each academic year, maintain excellent behavior at school and attend Pierce in continuous years.

The student(s) with the greatest financial need will be selected to receive the scholarship among equally qualified candidates. Renewal of the scholarship is dependent upon the scholar's continued high academic performance and excellent academic conduct.
